So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died. Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah. After he begot Methuselah, **Enoch walked with God** three hundred years, and had sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. **And Enoch walked with God;** and he was not, for God took him."

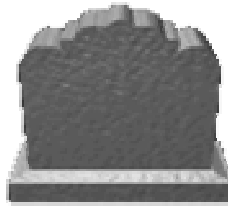
